Development of A Video Series...



- Project began in September 2016
- First step was to choose topics based on our expertise and opinion of the most challenges around respiratory disease and farm/hatchery management
- Initial topics included proper hatchery vaccination techniques and impact of ammonia on incidence of respiratory disease

Development of A Video Series...



- Videos were originally proposed to be 2-5 minutes each in length
- The University of Georgia Center for Teaching and Learning was contracted to do the filming/editing/production of the videos

- Everything was ready to go in November 2016, then....a majority of the staff at the CTL left for other jobs.
- CTL wasn't fully staffed and ready to shoot until March 2017
- Then the AI isolation from wild birds happened and shut down access to farms and hatcheries
- > By the time we were allowed back into facilities, it was very hot. Most of our videos revolve around cold weather situations, so we were waiting for winter to come again....

Development of A Video Series...



- But we were able to get into a hatchery for the first video, and were able to film the second video around what ammonia does to the respiratory tract and disease incidence in my lab
- These videos are in post-production and editing now, with a scheduled release in the next month or so
- The remaining videos are being scheduled on location so that they can be shot this winter
